Mr. Howes:

Staff from the South Dakota Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources (DANR) have reviewed the available information for the above-referenced property and determined that further assessment will not be required. DANR has determined, based on the available site information, there is no current risk to human health or further risk to the environment. Therefore, the department will assign No Further Action status to DANR file number 2017.028.

It should be noted that soil contamination above department action levels exists on site. If construction activities result in contaminated soil being removed, it must be properly disposed of at a permitted facility.

In addition, if future exposure pathways are created or if problems arise from the 18. contamination associated with this release, you may be responsible for performing additional assessment or clean-up activities. You may also be responsible for further assessment and cleanup actions if the use of this property changes, which increases the risk to human health and the environment from contamination documented at this property. All remaining monitoring wells must be properly abandoned in accordance with DANR's Well Construction Standards, ARSD 74:02:04, within 30 days. Written documentation showing the wells have been properly abandoned must be submitted to DANR.
